

Make A Rubber Egg!

Materials:

1 raw egg
vinegar
a cup

Directions:

1. Put the egg in the cup.
2. Pour vinegar over the egg so that the egg is completely covered.
3. Do you see anything happening?
4. Leave the egg overnight.
5. What happened?
6. Pour out the vinegar, and cover the egg with new vinegar.
7. Leave the egg for a few days.
8. What happened?

Want an explanation?

Vinegar is an "acid." When an egg is placed in an acid, it's shell breaks up into tiny pieces that are too small to see. Once this happens, what you see left over is everything on the inside of the eggshell.
